during the war, is hereby **Discharged** from the service of the United States

this *Twenty Third* day of *August*, 1865, at *Raleigh*

North Carolina by reason of [*I.O.**] *No. 154* [*O. J.**] *Dept. N.C.*

(No objection to his being re=enlisted is known to exist.*)

Said *Leander Harris* was born in *Hampsted*

In the State of *New Hampshire*, is *Twenty Nine* years of age,

Five feet ten inches high, *Light* complexion, *Blue* eyes,

Light hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a *Farmer*

Given at *Raleigh N.C.* this *Twenty third* day of

August 1865
